Minute 142 (b) Sandy Lane development, Ystradowen – Vale Council's road naming consultation .(Cllr Harbour).

Following consultation with residents the Vale's suggested names were rejected as of very little relevance to the locality.

A number of alternatives were proposed, the two most common being:

Otters Brook - the name of the stream that runs from the ridge at the Hensol-Talyfan road down through Wern Fawr farm into the Trout Farm off the A4229, also echoes the existing roads Badgers Brook etc"

Tudor Gardens/Grove/Walk – This has more of a connection to the village (Tudor Garage) and has a historic Welsh connotation.

Cllr Harbour advised that she had forwarded the above to the Vale Council 31st October 2024, a response is awaited.
